We invite all devotees across Zone 6 to join this sacred pilgrimage, **'100 Years of Pure Love"** and offer our obeisance to our Beloved Bhagawan. The pilgrimage will take place from **28th July to 3rd August 2025** and as such we request all devotees to arrive latest by the afternoon of 26th July as there will be orientation meeting taking place on Sunday 27th July.

"Life is a long pilgrimage along the rough and torturous road of this world. But, with the Name of God on his lips, the pilgrim will know no thirst; with the Form of God in his heart, he will feel no exhaustion. Please note that the registration for Bal Vikas children (SSE) and their parents will close on 28th February 2025 and for all other devotee's registration will close on 30th April 2025. This will allow sufficient time for Bal Vika play practices and secure in advance our accommodation in the Ashram. It will be mandatory for the group be staying within the Ashram. We kindly request that you do not delay your registration and do so at the earliest as an important part of any pilgrimage is the sadhana (spiritual practice) that we put in prior to our physical journey.

A schedule of offerings will be put together soon and once approved by Prasanthi this will be shared during our sadhana meetings.
